

WHO RECEIVES THE RESIDENT RATE?

- ⇒ Lives in Hamtramck OR
- ⇒ Enrolled in a Hamtramck Public School OR
- ⇒ Works in the Hamtramck Public School district.

Proof of residency, employment, or school enrollment is required. Only the person who lives in Hamtramck, or attends/works in the HPS district benefits from the resident rate.

REFUND POLICY

- Full refund will be given if a program is cancelled by the department. You must collect your funds or use it as a credit within two weeks of being notified.
- Refunds may be issued up until the start of the second class day, minus a \$5 processing fee, which can be used as a
 credit to enroll in another program if used the day refund is given.
- · Refunds for field trips will only be given one (1) week prior to scheduled trip date minus a \$5 processing fee
 - If trip date is on the weekend, refund can be requested no later than the Friday before the one (1)
 week mark
- Refunds will not be issued after the start of the second day of the any given program.
- Refunds are not given if class is cancelled due to weather, school closings, or scheduling conflicts. The department
 will do its best to offer make-up classes.




